

# PUBLIC CARAVAN AND CAMPING BOOKING DETAILS

Closing date for all applications – Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2024, or when all available pitches are fully booked.

13th AND 14th JULY 2024

We are planning to hold our annual Steam & Country Show on the above dates at Turn Post Farm, Wymeswold.

## PRICES AND BOOKINGS

#### **Availability**

Please Book as early as possible to guarantee your pitches as there will be a limited availability of pitches this year, due to changes to car parking arrangements following some problems in 2023. Once all pitches on the site are FULL it won't be possible to add anymore pitches.

N.B. Pitches are available on a first come first served basis until Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2024 at the latest, or when all available pitches are fully booked.

#### **Prices**

Public Caravan and Camping prices follow the simplified structure introduced in 2015 and consists of a single fee. The weekend pitch covers up to 4 nights (Thursday 11<sup>th</sup>, Friday 12<sup>th</sup>, Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 14<sup>th</sup>) for up to 2 Adults, accompanied children are FREE. Additional Adults will be charged at weekend prices.

N.B. Adults = 16 years and above, Children = up to and including 15 years.

The weekend pitch fee is based on 2 nights (Friday and Saturday) with 2 nights at no extra charge (Thursday and Sunday), for 2 Adults plus children, with a discount.

Prices are as follows:-

- £100.00 Weekend pitch fee Covers up to 4 nights for up to 2 Adults, accompanied children FREE. This covers admission to the Show on both days.
- £30.00 Weekend price for each additional Adult. This covers admission to the Show on both days.

# Single night pitches are NOT available in 2024.

Bookings and payment can be made either by post and cheque or online using e-mail and credit/debit card.

# **Bookings**

## N.B. BOOKINGS ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE.

N.B. Please do NOT send letters that require a signature on arrival, as this will delay delivery for several days as there is rarely anyone at home when Royal Mail deliver.

Although accompanied children are FREE we still need to know how many will be arriving, so that we can arrange for the necessary passes etc.

Please complete a separate Booking Form for each Pitch required.

Please send completed booking form/s and payment as described at the bottom of the Booking Form.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### General

- BOOKINGS ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE.
- Staying on the Public Caravan and Camping site gives you unlimited access to the show and entertainment.
- The Rempstone Traction Engine Club Committee reserves the right, and empowers Stewards, to refuse entry to or expel anyone who behaves in an anti-social manner or damages property.
- o If you wish to have several pitches sited together then a Group Booking is required. Group Bookings are acceptable for Pre-Bookings ONLY. Please fill in individual Booking Forms completing the "Group Booking Name" and "Expected Number of Pitches in Group" boxes on each Booking Form and we will arrange to site together.

Please complete separate Booking Forms for each Pitch required.

# Arrival and Departure

- No arrivals before 15:00 on Thursday 11th July 2024, unless by prior arrangement.
- o No arrivals after 21:00 on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2024, unless by prior arrangement.
- No arrivals before 10:00 or after 21:00 on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2024 and Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2024, unless by prior arrangement.
- All Caravans, Motorhomes, Campervans, Tents and RV's MUST leave site by 12:00 on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

#### Site

 The Rally site is farmland which is mainly grassed and can be uneven and slippery. Please take care and ensure you wear suitable footwear for this type of surface.

#### Pitches

N.B. See "Fire Regulations for Caravan Sites" on page 5, in conjunction with the terms below.

- o Pitches for Pre-Bookings will be pre-allocated at time of acceptance of booking.
- o Pitches will be 11 m. wide and 9 m. deep.
- Centre line of the caravan/motorhome/campervan/RV must be on the centre line of the pitch or to the right of the centre line if there is no awning.
- Tow hitches must be accessible from the roadway at all times, no exceptions. Continental caravans/motorhome/campervans/RV's with no awning can be parked in the same direction as other caravans/motorhomes/campervans/RV's if preferred; those with an awning should be parked the other way around with the tow hitch, if applicable, on the roadway at the rear.
- o Tents should have their cooking area as close to the centre line of the pitch as possible.
- Nothing is allowed in the 1.5 m. strip at the edge of each pitch, thus giving a 3 m. gap between units.
- There must be a 6 m. gap between adjacent accommodation (caravan, motorhome, campervan, awning, tent, RV).
- o Awnings are allowed. For safety reasons awnings must not face each other.
- Vehicles may be parked between accommodation, provided that the 3 m. gap between units is left clear and there is the 6 m. gap between adjacent accommodation.
   N.B. If a second vehicle is required, because of the total number of adults and children or because of different arrival times of the occupants, this is allowed at no extra cost provided both vehicles can be accommodated within the pitch length. Please specify both registration

- numbers on the Booking Form along with the number of adults and children arriving in each vehicle to allow passes to be produced for both vehicles.
- The Rally site is farmland which is mainly grassed and can be uneven, and pitches are unlikely to be totally level. Please ensure you have sufficient blocks / ramps / chocks available to level your unit.
- NO EHU available on site.
- We have a small number of Disabled pitches adjacent to the Show fields. These are allocated on a first come first served basis.

# Safety, Security and Comfort

- There is a 5 m.p.h. speed restriction on site, which MUST be adhered to at all times. The
  exceptions will be any emergency services, security and occasionally show service vehicles.
- o All drivers must hold a full driving licence for the type of vehicle being driven.
- Motorised trikes and quad bikes must NOT be used. The exceptions will be any emergency services, security and occasionally show service vehicles.
- The gates will be locked between 23:00 and 07:00.
- Vehicle movement on site is prohibited between 23:00 and 07:00.
- Noise should be kept to a minimum between 23:00 and 07:00.
- Generators may be used, at the discretion of the site stewards, between 09:00 and 21:00.
   Please ensure that fuel is stored in approved and marked containers, that exhausts do not annoy adjoining pitches, and that all necessary safety precautions are taken with connections.
- The use of drones is **NOT** allowed on the Public Caravan and Camping site, Show fields, Exhibitor Camping fields, or Car Park at any time, except with the written permission of the organisers.

# Payments

Payment for Pre-Bookings MUST be made at the time of booking, to guarantee pitches.

#### Visitors

- If you have visitors they will be asked to park near to the entrance gate of the Public Caravan and Camping site, to minimise vehicle movement on site. For those with mobility issues a limited amount of parking will be available near the entrance to the Show fields.
- Visitors will be charged the daily entrance fee (£15.00 per Adult per day, accompanied children FREE) to access the Show.

## Water, Sanitation and Rubbish

- Fresh drinking water will be available from several locations around the site. Please ensure taps are fully turned off after use.
- Taps designated as drinking water MUST NOT be used for any other purpose, i.e.
   washing hands or cleaning chemical toilets.
- Chemical toilets MUST only be emptied in the chemical disposal tanks which will be located around the site.
- o It is not always possible to locate the chemical disposal tanks near to a tap designated for cleaning chemical toilets. You MUST NOT take your chemical toilets to a tap designated as drinking water to clean it, please take water in a suitable container (bucket, watering can, etc.) to the chemical disposal tanks to clean your chemical toilet.
- Grey water may be disposed of on the ground, following sensible precautions.
- Toilet facilities will be available from the afternoon of Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2024 until 09:00 on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024.
  - N.B. There will only be limited toilet facilities available from the evening of Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2024 until 09:00 on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024.
- o Please do **NOT** use toilets for emptying chemical waste or grey water.
- Please take your rubbish home as we have to pay to dispose of all rubbish left on the site and this reduces the amount we are able to donate to charity. If in exceptional

circumstances you are unable to take your rubbish home, please place it in one of the bins provided. If your nearest bin is full please find another as waste left on the ground encourages vermin and increases our clean-up costs.

# • Barbeques and Campfires

- Only gas or charcoal barbeques are allowed. Barbeques should be placed on a suitable stand and not directly on the grass.
- Please ensure that the ground does not get damaged.
- Campfires and Firepits are NOT permitted.

#### Pets

- o Pets are welcome on site but you are responsible for the behaviour of your animals.
- Please ensure that your animals are not allowed loose on site and are kept on a lead no longer than 2 metres, no exceptions.
- Pets must NOT be left in an unattended vehicle. Rempstone Traction Engine Club reserve
  the right to forcibly enter a vehicle should we observe and believe that an animal is in
  distress and the authorities will be informed.
- o Any fouling must be cleaned up and disposed of in the waste bins or skips.



# **Fire Regulations for Caravan Sites**

Pegs set at 11m. spacing, offset 1.5m. from centre of pitch.

Each pitch 9m. deep

Roadway each side 6m. (5.5m. min).



Centre line of caravan/motorhome/campervan/tent/RV must be 1.5m. to the right of the peg.

Tow hitch must be accessible from the roadway.

No vehicle or awning to be within 1.5m. of the adjacent boundaries.
